National President Shri Amit Shah was in Rajasthan on his extensive nation-wide travel programme from 21st July to 23rd July 2017. In this organisational visit, Shri Amit Shah assured party workers that BJP is again going to form the government in Rajasthan. During this visit Shri Shah held meetings with party office bearers and gave them directions for the efficient functioning of various departments and projects of the state unit of BJP. He also interacted with intellectuals of the state and discussed about the policies of the Party and public welfare schemes of Central and State Government. This three day visit of the National President has benefitted the BJP extensively on the organisational front and for expanding the popular base for the party. There were some remarkable achievements of this visit, which is discussed below:

- During his three day visit, BJP National President has assured workers from various fora that on the basis of development work done by the Modi Government at the Centre and the Vasundhara Raje Government in the state, BJP is going to form the government once again in the state with an even larger mandate than 2013.
- Mentioning the possibility of over-confidence and laziness among party workers because of the huge mandate that BJP got in 2013 Assembly Election and 2014 General Election, National President Shri Amit Shah warned everyone that this is not the time to take rest, rather this opportunity should be utilized in strengthening the party organization, which will reinforce the invincibility of BJP in Rajasthan. This message of Shri Shah encouraged and energized party workers.
- During his three-day visit, Shri Shah spoke of the increase of two and a half times in the fund allocation to the state by the Central government and highlighted the sensitivity of Central government towards the development of the State. Shri Shah also formulated a working module for spreading the benefits received by Rajasthan Government through various important schemes of the Central Government. The main schemes of the Central Government and the benefits given to Rajasthan under them are as follows:
Jandhan Yojana (Rs. 5043 crore has been deposited in 1.96 crore bank accounts), Mudra Yojana (26.13 lakh beneficiaries received loan of Rs. 15,711 crore), Ujjwala Scheme (20.38 lakh female beneficiaries), 2 smart cities (Jaipur and Udaipur), personal toilets (86,895) and public toilets (3558) etc. In addition he also mentioned the popular schemes of the State Government like Bhamashah Yojana, Ration distribution, Chief Minister's Water Swavlamban campaign, Annapurna Bhandar Yojana etc.
- After carefully hearing out the representatives of the party and the Government on the issue of coordination between party and Government, Shri Shah finalised an efficient coordination mechanism between them. Because of this effort by Shri Shah, a feeling of belongingness with the Government will grow among the common workers, and hence they will work more enthusiastically to bring the good works of the government to the public.
- Keeping in focus party workers from booth level to state level, Shri Shah finalised various programs for the expansion of the party; among them Pt. Deendayal Upadhyaya Vistarak Yojana is most important. Sri Shah himself trained the fulltime Vistaraks and encouraged them. Apart from this he also set targets for them which will definitely strengthen party at the booth level. Shri Shah also discussed about the importance and workings of 19 departments and 9 projects of the party with its coordinators, this will give a definite direction and stability to the party.
- Shri Shah inspected the progress in 'Aajeevan Sahyog Nidhi' project which has been initiated to bring total economic integrity in the party functioning. This has given a very strong message of integrity and honesty in public life among the party cadre.
- National President Shri Shah also stressed on the importance of social media in the current political scenario and finalised a route map to bring its various techniques upto booth level in order to strengthen the information dissemination system of the party.

Project 'NAMAMI GANGE'

The importance of rivers in India is not only limited to the dimension of water but it is also considered as a part of our cultural heritage. After the BJP government was formed in the center, concrete initiatives have been taken for keeping rivers clean, connecting them with canals, taking measures for their proper maintenance and for optimal and balanced utilization of river water. In such a situation, as a responsive political party, the Bharatiya Janata Party has understood and accepted its responsibility to contribute towards the mission of cleaning rivers, 'Ganga' and "Namami Gange Project" is an initial step towards this goal. The following work and responsibilities have been finalized under this project:

- This project is mainly for those states through which the river 'Ganga' flows. The objective of this project is to ensure our participation in the campaign of cleaning and preserving the purity of the river 'Ganga'.
- In those States where Ganga does not flow, the state units should select a river and work in towards preserving its purity. The project should define its responsibility for ensuring the cleanliness of that river.
- Under this project, the issue of maintaining cleanliness of river water should be discussed and after that a plan should be drawn. This should be followed by proper execution of that plan. For this, the project should also start a public awareness drive to spread information regarding the importance of rivers and their cleanliness.
- Time limit for proper implementation of the plan should be fixed and the same should be completed on time. It is the responsibility of the Project that while framing the plan, work should be done according to the project booklet and the responsibilities of workers associated with the project should be defined so that the projects can achieve their objectives in a time bound manner.

Shri Amit Shah's Thoughts on 'NAMAMI GANGE'

The rapid depletion of water sources is a matter of concern not just for India but for the entire world. The only solution to this problem is the rejuvenation of rivers and other water bodies. Inspired by PM Narendra Modi's vision the 'Namami Gange' project strives for the same. It is not only the government which is entrusted with this task; rather a mass movement is required to achieve the goals of the Namami Gange project. As a responsible political party, it is the duty of every BJP worker to become a part of this mass movement and serve Mother Earth.

During the last tenure of the UPA Government, the 13th Finance Commission had allotted only Rs. 84,426 crores as Rajasthan's stake in the Central Tax, while the Modi Government, in the 14th Finance Commission, has allotted Rs. 2,18,145 crores to Rajasthan, which is three times more than what was given in 13th Finance Commission under the UPA government.

The grant amount which was previously given to Rajasthan was only Rs. 13,108 Crores, but in the 14th Finance Commission this amount has been increased by more than one and a half times and Rs. 22,717 crores have been given to Rajasthan.

Even after 70 years of independence, there were about eight crore households in the country which had no toilets. The Modi government has given the right to live with dignity to the poor women of the village by creating more than four and a half million toilets in just three years.

Electrification work has been completed in about 13,000 villages, out of 18,000 deprived villages and it is targeted that after May 2018, there will not be a single village in the country where there is no electricity.

BJP government believes in actual delivery of welfare programmes to the public rather than merely talking about it.

A party which has no ideology cannot work for the betterment and development of the country.

Over the years, we have overthrown the three cancers- politics of dynasty, politics of casteism and politics of appeasement- from the country.
