In 2017 UP assembly elections BJP won with a huge mandate. After the declaration of election results, BJP National President Shri Amit Shah was in Uttar Pradesh on 29th, 30th and 31st of July for his nationwide organisational visit program. In this organisational visit BJP National President instructed workers to fulfill the expectations of people of UP through a 'Sankalp Patra' and to spread the policies of the Government at the grassroot level. This organisational visit of BJP National President was very inspiring for all party workers who have worked with dedication and devotion even during the hard times. In that context the Party is considering this as an important visit:

- Recalling the misrule of SP and BSP governments over the last one and half decade, Shri Amit Shah cautioned the state leadership and party workers from various forums that the unprecedented mandate for the BJP in 2014 LS elections and 2017 Assembly elections is a reflection of the faith that people have placed on BJP. Hence it is the responsibility of the party to work selflessly. The feeling of being in power should never dominate in our minds otherwise there will be no difference between BJP and other political parties. Such guidance by Shri Shah will guide workers and especially the state leadership to work for public welfare selflessly.
- Due to Shri Amit Shah's intervention the party organization has been very organised and united in the past four years in Uttar Pradesh, but in this three day visit BJP National President specifically cautioned Party workers while taking note of possibilities of laxity among them as a result of the huge victory in past two elections. He reminded the party workers that with perseverance and tireless attitude they should recognize their shortcomings and work on rectifying them. These observations by National President sent a very positive message down the cadre.
- In various meetings, Shri. Amit Shah gave opportunity to even booth level Party workers to present their views without any hesitation or inhibition. Due to this various affirmative and constructive suggestions came forth regarding the working of government and organisation. Assurance given by the National President for appropriate actions on the relevant suggestions made by workers sent a positive message among the Party cadre.
- Shri Amit Shah assured all possible assistance for the development of the state by the central government and said that there is almost a two-and-a-half-fold increase in the amount received by the state from the Center (from 3,30,807 crore to 8,08,612 crore), which shall be utilized for all-round development of the state.
- Referring to a dozen public welfare schemes of Central government which benefit Uttar Pradesh, Shri Amit Shah said 59 lakh Ujjwala gas cylinders beneficiaries, 72 lakhs Mudra scheme beneficiaries, 4.48 lakh new toilets and farmer loan waiver scheme in such a short span of the government, has been possible because of strong cooperation between the State and Central government, and due to this UP will enter the league of developed states in just a few years. National President's call to Party workers for publicising the development work done by the BJP Government has definitely strengthen the Party and the government.
- During this visit Shri Amit Shah, on various occasions, reminded the workers of the support extended by the poor and backward class along with the schedule communities for the success of BJP and directed the Party and government representatives to give special attention to these communities and to associate them with the Party in large numbers. These efforts by the National President shall definitely help BJP to expand its base in these communities.
- Shri Shah was appraised of the impact and efficient workings of social media wing of Party during last Assembly elections, however he suggested new goals for the future expansion of this wing which shall further strengthen the public campaign strategy.

National Program and Meeting Department

Being a national political Party, the Bharatiya Janata Party organizes various programs simultaneously in different parts of the country.

Due to wide organizational expansion of the party, there are always some events or meetings happening somewhere in the country almost on a daily basis.

In order to organize these programs and meetings in a systematic and hassle-free manner, the Party has prepared the structure of 'National Program and Meeting Department'. The key objective behind the establishment of this structure is to ensure that programs and meetings are arranged in line with mutual understanding and coordination. This department has been structured for uniformity and coordination in the party organization and its various bodies.

There are following objectives of this department:

- It has been determined by the Party that the National Program and Meeting Department shall decide about the purpose and goals for the concerned program with a common consensus.
- In this regard, responsibility for deciding the subject matter and management of the program is also kept under this department.
- Keeping an eye on the management of national level party programs and meetings, thereby developing a useful working system, has been entrusted upon the party's National Program and Meeting Department so as to implement these programs effectively.
- The feedback related to various programs and meetings are to be taken under consideration by the National Program and Meeting Department in order to reduce shortcomings related to programme management in the future events.
- The responsibility and obligation to regularly evaluate and note the need for such programs and meetings and their significance for the party has been given to this department.

Views of Shri Amit Shah on the National Program and Meeting Department

It has been the tradition of BJP to organize programs and meetings regularly for public relations so that proper communication in the organization is maintained. Being the largest party in the world it organizes different programs and meetings in different parts of the country which runs at the same time. The role of the National Program and Meeting Department is crucial for hassle-free organization and coordination of these programs and meetings thereby maintaining their effectiveness for the party. Therefore, it becomes important for this department to regularly evaluate the administrative mechanism for these programs and meetings and maintain their structural uniformity.

The Bharatiya Janata Party Government even earlier stood firmly with Uttar Pradesh but our plans did not reach the people of the state due to the negligence of the SP Government. Today the Yogi government is engaged in prompt delivery of the pro-poor welfare schemes to the people of the state.

After the formation of the BJP Government in UP, the farmers' debt was waived off in the first cabinet meeting. So far about 38 lakh tons of wheat has been purchased, which is a record in itself.

During the UPA Government, Uttar Pradesh got only Rs. 523 crores as local body grants. The Modi Government made an unprecedented increase in it and raised it by 88 times thereby allocating 46,024 crores rupees to the state.

If all grants given by the Modi Government to Uttar Pradesh are summed up then it is about 2.3 times more than what was given by the previous UPA Government.

Under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, we have adopted an all-pervasive and all-inclusive development model keeping the goals of Antyodaya as our main motto.

The fundamental principles of the Bharatiya Janata Party's journey from its foundation as Jana Sangh till date (1950-2017) remain the same i.e. Antodaya, Integral Humanism and Cultural Nationalism. A party which has no ideology cannot develop the country. Bharatiya Janata Party is the only party which functions on the basis of principles and works to restore the lost glory of the nation.

The share of Uttar Pradesh in the central tax was Rs. 2,80,467 crores in the 13th Finance Commission during the UPA government while in the Modi government it has increased up to Rs. 7,10,966 crores in the 14th Finance Commission.

In the 13th Finance Commission, during the UPA Government, Uttar Pradesh received grants-in-aid of 24 thousand crore rupees only, which the Modi Government has doubled up to 48 thousand crore rupees. Additional assistance of Rs 1,39,052 crores has also been made available to Uttar Pradesh for various central schemes.

90.68 % of the arrears of sugarcane farmers have been paid off, which in itself is a huge achievement. It is evident that the arrears of sugar cane farmers were not paid due to the collusion between SP-BSP.

Under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the campaign against black money was started in a scientific and planned manner which resulted in the seizure of black money of thousands of crores. Such bold steps have not been taken so widely to curb the menace of black money since independence.
