On the occasion of Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya centenary year a schedule of countrywide visits and programmes has been put in place for BJP national president Shri Amit Shah. Under the extended tour programme – Vistrit Pravas – BJP national president Shri Amit Shah visited Himachal Pradesh on 3rd and 4th May 2017. During these two days Shri Shah interacted with workers and office bearers from the district and state levels, addressed intellectuals and eminent citizens, met family members of martyrs and honoured the father of a widely revered young martyr and also held meetings of the party's departments and special projects. In terms of the party organisation in Himachal Pradesh this visit was particularly useful.

- 8.40** Departs from Delhi residence for airport
- 10.40** Departs from Delhi airport for Dharamshala
- 11.50** Enthusiastically welcomed at Dharamshala by office bearers and thousands of workers
- 11.55** Proceeds by road to Palampur, Kangra, along the way, at least at a dozen places, party workers overwhelmingly welcome him
- 12.50** Reaches Palampur, Kangra
- 2.00** At Buddhamal Kaisal, Palampur, meeting with core group members and discussion on various aspects and issues pertaining to the organisation
- 3.15** Press Conference at Buddhamal Kaisal
- 4.30** Meets workers and office bearers from districts and they, while participating in the discussion, have the opportunity of placing organisational and other issues directly before the national president

ACHIEVEMENT



B JP national president Shri Amit Shah was recently on a two-day tour of Himachal Pradesh in connection with the Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Vistarak Yojana. The meetings, events, and activities conducted in his presence have energised the state organisation. Quite apart from boosting the morale of the cadre, it was a good occasion to propagate and disseminate the party's ideology and agenda. The trip yielded multiple positive results.

- On the very first day of the tour, Shri Shah met up with all district level office bearers and workers of the state unit. That such a meeting would instill confidence among the lowest rungs of the cadre was only expected. Judged by the reactions, a new sense of purpose was visible among the attendees. It was seen as a highly positive signal.
- A sizeable section of Himachal Pradesh's populace serving with the country's armed forces could not cast their vote in the last assembly poll. Shri Shah instructed the party's state election department to facilitate the casting of their franchise in the future and to ensure that their interests were looked after.
- In Himachal Pradesh, the BSP has been continuously losing ground and the central government under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has successfully implemented welfare schemes and projects for the dalits and poorer sections of society thus earning their support and goodwill. Taking this scenario into consideration BJP national president asked party workers and leaders to further extend the party organisation and the policies of the central government among the dalits and spoke on the need to further strengthen the peoples' support.
- Shri Shah directed the state unit to collect and collate old photographs and biographical material on great local personalities instrumental in spreading the party's cause in the state. A glimpse into their lives, he said, would inspire the cadre and strengthen their commitment to the party's cause and ideals.
- Himachal, said Shri Shah in his address to the intelligentsia, was a land of the brave. The state had regularly, over the decades, sent its sons to defend the nation's borders. The Modi regime, on its part, had fulfilled the Army's long overdue demand of One Rank One Pension (OROP). He said he was only too well aware of the sacrifices made by the state's citizens in the defense of the country.
- In one particular function, the BJP national president commended the father of martyr Captain Saurabh Kalia. Such a gesture made out of a genuine sense of tribute and of nationalism has been appreciated by the personnel of the armed forces and their families.
- Under the 13th Finance Commission, Himachal Pradesh's share in the allocation of resources was Rs 11,131 crore. The Modi government had scaled it up to a whopping Rs 28,225 crore. Again, under the UPA regime, Himachal Pradesh used to get a revenue deficit grant of Rs 7,889 crore which the Modi regime has multiplied nearly six times to Rs 40,625 crore.
- Shri Shah repeatedly stressed the need for organisational unity during his talk with party workers. Only a selfless approach to work would pay dividends in the long run, he said. The message went down well among the cadres.
- As reiterated earlier, the initiatives taken by Shri Shah through the Aajeevan Sahayog Nidhi to render the party's day-to-day operations more transparent has motivated lakhs of party workers. This would further buttress the BJP's reputation of being "a party with a difference".

Ajeevan Sahayog Nidhi

The core values of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) are inherent and implicit in the precept, “Party with a difference”. The BJP is, amid the clutch of parties lacking in inner democracy and transparency, an exemplar of organisational unity and discipline. Transparency necessarily depends on how the party treasury is run and funds handled. The BJP has proved itself well above board in every aspect of fiscal probity right since its foundation. In the process it has lived up to the high standards of uprightness and openness advocated by Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya. It continues to follow his guidelines. To ensure that the funds collected by dint of the hard work put in by workers, a separate Ajeewan Sahayog Nidhi department has been created as a key wing of the party. During his tour of Himachal Pradesh, the BJP’s national president, Shri Amit Shah, specifically said that the Ajeewan Sahayog Nidhi was the cornerstone of the party’s treasury.

- Creation of the Ajeewan Sahayog Nidhi as a standalone department of the BJP represents the highest yardstick of probity and fiscal discipline within political parties;
- To strengthen the working of its treasury, the BJP is determined to bring Ajeewan Sahyog Nidhi to the mainstream by streamlining its function;
- The overall purpose of the Ajeewan Sahayog Nidhi is to ensure that every state unit of the party is run solely on the strength of the funds collected by its workers in a transparent manner;
- The Sahayog Nidhi has been created to fix goals, ensure accountability and fix responsibility at every level of the party’s functioning from the divisional to the district level in every state;
- The sole criteria for fixing five-year targets under the Sahayog Nidhi at the divisional and district level of party units should be whether their expenses can be met from the interest received from the collections;
- Funds received under Ajeewan Sahayog Nidhi should be through the medium of bank cheques. The BJP regime at the Centre has lived up to the highest standards of financial prudence and probity by supporting political donations above Rs 2000/- by cheque alone.

The Views of Shri Amit Shah on Ajeewan Sahayog Nidhi

The ambit of the party’s activities for the next five years will necessarily depend on how strong the Ajeewan Sahayog Nidhi department can be made. The BJP is committed on the Fund’s transparency. Only when the purest blood is made to flow through the arteries of a political party can its ideal of being taint free be realised amidst a surrounding of contamination.

Salient Points of Shri Amit Shah's speeches during his Himachal Pradesh Pravas
