Bharatiya Janata Party is observing the centenary of Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya's as the 'Garib Kalyan' (welfare of the poor) year across the country. The vision of the Garib Kalyan year is centered on the concept of Antodaya. Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya had envisioned Integral Humanism and Antodaya, it is now being realised and implemented under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and through the ideological direction of the BJP. Today, when the BJP is celebrating Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya's birth centenary year as Garib Kalyan year, the mission of spreading the message of policies that are inspired by the vision of Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya, to people across the country assumes great significance. April 25, 2017

(8:15 am to 12:00 am)

- 8:15** Departs from Delhi
- 11:30** National President Shri Amit Shah arrives at Bagdogra Airport, Siliguri. On arrival in West Bengal, party office bearers and workers welcomed the national president with great enthusiasm.
- 11:45** Siliguri Club Montana vista, departure for Darjeeling
- 12:00** Mr. Amit Shah arrived at Syliguri Club Montana Vista and meeting and discussions with party office bearers
- 12:30** Shri Amit Shah leaves for Naxalbari assembly segment
- 1:00** At Naxalbari booth number 93, takes lunch at the house of Shri Raju Mahali and Smt Geeta Mahali
- 1:30** Shri Amit Shah interacts with and addresses workers at Naxalbari booth number 93 and carries out his own duties as a Vistarak under Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Vistarak Yojana.

- 3:00** Met 6 families under the contact campaign at Naxalbari booth number 93 and interacts with them.
- 4:30** Leaves for Siliguri Indoor Stadium.
- 6:00** Participates in a dialogue programme with intellectuals at Siliguri Indoor Stadium and addresses them.
- 6:30** Leaves for Siddhivinayak Bhawan.
- 7:30** At the Siddhi Vinayak Bhavan, meets with districts presidents of eight districts of West Bengal, interacted with them, had dinner and left at 8:30 for the railway station.
- 8:45** Meeting with party officials at New Jalpaiguri railway station.
- 9:00** Departure for Kolkata By Train with party office bearers.
- 10:30** Meeting on West Bengal with party office bearers on board the train.
- 12:00** Retires for the night.

Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Vistarak Yojana

Bharatiya Janata Party is celebrating the birth centenary of Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya and the Deendayal UpadhyayBooth Vistarak Yojana is an important part of the scheme. The three-day West Bengal visit of BJP National President Shri Amit Shah has benefited the party at various levels. The following have been the broad achievements of the tour Vistarak tour undertaken by BJP National President Shri Amit Shah

Salient points from various addresses delivered by BJP National President Shri Amit Shah during his West Bengal tour:

The BJP government at the centre led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has in the last three years worked tirelessly for the upliftment of the poor and has tried to reach these schemes to the remotest villages but the Trinamool Congress government of West Bengal does not allow these plans to reach the grassroots.

Regularly, every three years our organisational elections are held from the booth level to the level of the national president, according to our constitution and at the appointed time.
