Mission 120



The three-day organizational visit to Odisha by the National President of Bharatiya Janata Party has been very useful in strengthening the organization and is seen in the best interests of the party. During this visit, Shri Amit Shah took part in various programs, had meetings with party office-bearers and party workers, and this has resulted in strengthening the organizational base of the party in Odisha. This organizational visit was of extreme importance in many ways. The Party is seeing this visit of the National President Shri Amit Shah as very useful for the organisation.

- The way thousands of workers welcomed Shri Amit Shah at every corner and crossroad during the course of his road journey spanning more than 600 kms indicates the bright future of the party in the state. Shri Shah, who is hailed as the Chanakya of electoral politics, has set a target of 120 seats for BJP in 2019 state elections, and this proves that BJP is going to form the next government in Odisha. Following the huge success of BJP in the Panchayat elections, Shri Shah has succeeded in boosting the morale of the state party workers many folds during his three-day organizational stay.
- Addressing thousands of booth workers, Shri Shah heavily criticized the BJD government for the extreme backwardness and poverty prevailing in the state. He attributed this failure to the present leadership of Odisha. Shri Shah gave a call to the people of Odisha to support the BJP for including the state in the cycle of the countrywide developmental programs of the Modi government. He certainly found success in awakening aspirations of the people of Odisha which was dormant for decades. And this would definitely be of great benefit to the BJP.
- As a part of booth expansion, Shri Shah undertook the campaign in three rural booths by doing a door-to-door campaign for the party and affixed party posters on the walls of the houses. In these booths, Shri Shah himself had meetings with booth workers and formed booth committees. Seeing their national president working as a simple booth Vistarak with such great vigor, a positive message spread among the party workers and this will definitely help strengthen the BJP at booth levels in Odisha.
- Winning 34 out of 36 seats in panchayat elections in Kalahandi, one of the poorest districts in India, reflects that the poor have utmost faith in BJP and in Prime Minister Modi's leadership. Shri Shah, during his booth visits, went to the houses of the Dalits and backward families, and the way he mingled with them by having simple food cooked in the households resulted in him building a warm relationship with the poorest sections of society in Odisha.
- During his Odisha visit, Shri Shah, on various occasions, said that the Modi government is sensitive to the development of Odisha, as a result of which it has given Rs 4 lakh crores in last three years for the development of the state, which is multiple times higher than what was being given by the previous government. In this regard, Shri Shah also underlined the commitment of Modi government to develop East India. With this attempt, a message was spread among the common masses of Odisha to support the Modi government and the BJP, and this will positively benefit the party.
- Shri Amit Shah recalled several instances associated with the glory of Odisha at various events and programs thereby touching the emotions of the people of Odisha. Furthering the tradition of saluting martyrs' families during the Odisha executive meet by PM Modi, National President Shri Shah also honored the famous Paika Revolutionaries of 1817 and synchronized the public sentiment of the state with the BJP. During his booth program at booth No. 191 of Basantpur village, Shri Shah remembered the 'Daya River' that occupies prominence in the heroic history of Odisha, which touched the heart of the commons of Odisha.



Good Governance and Center-State Governance Coordination Department

At present, the foundation of Bharatiya Janata Party and its organization have been expanded across the whole country. The government of Bharatiya Janata Party and its Allies are ruling in 18 states of the country. In the centre, the full majority Government of BJP led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi is also working successfully. In such a situation, establishing a positive and pro-active coordination between the party's organization, the central government and the state governments becomes very important. In the state, it is necessary to monitor and closely follow the plans that are being implemented successfully, evaluate which plan of the Center is doing better in the states, and while taking these into account to prepare a coordinated policy, the party has established the 'Good Governance and the Center-State Governance Programme Coordination Department'. The objective behind establishing this department is to prepare frameworks towards policy co-ordination between the state and the centre, as well as to prepare and effectuate policies that are centered on peoples' welfare. The responsibilities of this department is explained herein below:

- The main responsibility for the Good Governance Department and the Centre-State Governance Programme coordination department is to organize conferences of Ministers of the Union and BJP-governed states for a better understanding of the best practices in governances being implemented across various states and at the Centre
- The main responsibility of this department is to organize conferences and programmes through which the policies related to special issues/subjects, plans and programmes of the party can be co-ordinated and given a direction towards their implementation.
- The Department is entrusted with the task of coordinating with other states to encourage those states in taking bold steps to implement the strategies which have borne fruits in one state.
- The main responsibility of the Good Governance and Centre-State Governance Programme Coordination Department is to publicize and take to the masses various public welfare schemes of the Government. This Department also has the mandate to make proper arrangements for research and publication of these successful public welfare schemes and disseminate information and details about these to public at large.
- Another main responsibility of the Department is to document the negative write-ups, news clippings, reports, videos and other documents related to the plans, programmes and policies of the Government and share them at the appropriate forum.

Shri Amit Shah's Thoughts on the Good Governance and Center-State Governance Coordination Department

The responsibility of the Good Governance & Centre and State Governance Coordination Department is to ensure that message of initiatives for peoples' welfare undertaken by the Centre and our state governments are well documented, evaluated and disseminated among people. Apart from this, the department has to ensure that it organises conferences of those ministers whose ministries are directly working for peoples' welfare and ensure that there is an interaction and exchange of ideas among them. Based on these exchanges, the department has to help in working out comprehensive programmes centered on the philosophy of peoples' welfare.
