

A strong and self-dependent BJP



National BJP president Amit Shah was on a three day tour of Maharashtra as part of his countrywide extended tour programme. A part from attending a number of programmes, he also addressed a clutch of meetings and had meaningful discussions with party office bearers and workers. The visit was a confidence booster for the party's Maharashtra state unit, and should prove beneficial in a number of ways.

- During the three-day stopover, Shri Shah made it amply clear that though the BJP respected the coalition dharma, it would never compromise on the state or national interest merely to stay in power. Party workers were told in no uncertain terms that a strong and self-dependent BJP was impossible without a strong presence at the booth level.
- The party's alliance with the Shiv Sena for long years had impacted its organisational growth in many areas of the state. Shri Shah not only identified these areas but also appealed to party workers to plug these gaps at the earliest to ensure better results in forthcoming polls. Identifying the weak spots was seen as a significant step in paving the way for the BJP's expansion across

the length and breadth of Maharashtra.

- Shri Shah set tough goals for those working full-time under the Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Vistarak yojana. But he also took cognizance of the problems faced by them at the ground level, and gave a pep talk on how to fulfil their tasks. Specific responsibilities were handed out to senior ministers and office bearers, and a framework laid out to coordinate with field level workers. The impact of the party president's words were instant, and entirely in the organisational interest.
- It was widely felt that Shri Shah's joint address to senior representatives of the government and party would help improve coordination between the two. This would translate into speedier and better implementation of the government's people oriented schemes. The confidence expressed in the leadership of Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis would also strengthen the party.
- The Central budgetary allocations made by the Modi government to Maharashtra, said Shri Shah, had risen from Rs 1,15,539 crore to Rs 2,84,184 crore. There were number of other disbursements running into several crores. All of this showed the Modi regime's sensitivity to the state's needs which the state's electorate could scarcely afford to ignore.
- Shri Shah interact with key members of the state's film industry to understand the nature of their problems was much appreciated. By assuring them of all assistance, he sent out a firm message that the BJP cared for the state's cultural interests.
- In his meeting with intellectuals, Shri Shah dwelt at length on the party's ideology and what distinguished it from other parties. His interaction with them should convince people that the BJP's was an outfit whose priority was good governance and national interest.
- By garlanding the statue of Chhatrapati Shivaji, Shri Shah made it evident that the BJP always had a special affinity for Maratha honour and pride. The homage paid to Shiv Sena founder Balasaheb Thakeray was in keeping with the BJP's time honoured tradition of rising above competitive politics to show its regard for great leaders.



Help and disaster relief services department


Not for nothing is the BJP known as a political party with a difference. Quite apart from discharging its political functions, it is also deeply aware of its social duties which it tries to carry out in letter and spirit.

The party firmly believes that no political outfit can attain its goals to the fullest unless its workers are committed to the social betterment and upliftment of common people. Central to it is the desire to help. Coordination between the party's political and social functions is thus an absolute must. This is the *raison d'être* behind the decision to set up the department of Help and Disaster Relief Services in the party. Its specific functions are worth understanding.

- Making proper arrangements to ensure that members of the public, and party workers, have no difficulty in meeting ministers at the party's key offices. It is the job of its staffers to prepare a formal blueprint on how exactly it wishes to carry out its tasks and functions.
- It is the responsibility of this department to review its shortcomings from time to time, and ensure that the gaps are plugged at the earliest. This is necessary to maintain the quality of services.
- Apart from keeping the lines of communication between party workers and ministers open, it is the job of the department to see that the problems of workers are resolved at the earliest.
- Natural disasters strike various parts of the country. In such situations those attached to this department will be expected to provide whatever relief can be gathered from various quarters — and also lend a helping hand to others in reaching out to the sufferers and victims.
- The department will also be expected to help out in areas other than those connected with natural disasters whenever necessary. A rough and ready plan of action should be put in place for such eventualities which can be invoked at the right time.

Shri Amit Shah's Views on help and Disaster Relief Services Department

As a national party, it is the duty of every BJP worker to serve society in every possible way, both individually and collectively. Our responsibility quadruples during natural disasters and other emergencies. So if disaster strikes any corner of the country, it is the job of the 'Help and Disaster Relief Service Department' to gather relief material at the local level and dispatch it to the affected state.

The Congress led UPA government had, during the tenure of the 14th Finance Commission, fixed Rs 74,104 crore as Maharashtra’s share in Central taxes. The Modi regime had, in the 15th Finance Commission, jacked this up to Rs 2,19,165 crore. Similarly grant-in-aid has also been scaled up to Rs 33,595 crore from Rs 16,331 crore.



Maharashtra’s disaster management grant has been upped from Rs 1,835 crore to Rs 6,140 crore. Grants to local bodies have gone up from Rs 8,497 crore to Rs 27,448 crore. The sum total of Central aid handed out to the state has thus been in the region of Rs 1,60,000 crore.



Furthermore Rs 26,000 crore had been disbursed under the Prime Minister’s Agricultural Irrigation Scheme, and a separate Rs 3,050 crore to deal with the 2015 drought.



The principal difference between the Congress and the BJP is this: While the Congress wants to rebuild the country by putting its past on the back burner, the BJP wants to do the same by keeping the grandeur of its ancient heritage as a permanent reference point.
