The New Cabinet

- Cabinet expansion was held on 7th July 2021 first time after May 2019. A total of 43 members of parliament took oath.
- Also, In a historic move, a separate 'Ministry of Co-operation' has been created by the Central Government for realizing the vision of 'Sahkar se Samriddhi'. This ministry will provide a separate administrative, legal and policy framework for strengthening the cooperative movement in the country. It will work to streamline processes for 'Ease of doing business' for co-operatives and enable development of Multi-State Co-operatives (MSCS).

Cabinet approves "India COVID 19 Emergency Response and Health Systems Preparedness Package: Phase II" at a cost of Rs 23,123 crore

"India COVID-19 Emergency Response and Health Systems Preparedness Project: Phase-II" would be implemented at a total cost of \square 23,123 Crore, from 01" July 2021 to 31" March 2022.

With the focus on immediate needs for the next nine months of FY 21-22, to provide support to Central government hospitals / agencies and to State/UT Governments to augment their existing response to the second wave and the evolving pandemic, including at district and sub district levels in peripheral facilities.

KVIC Secures Trademark Registrations in Bhutan, UAE & Mexico; Files Applications in 40 Countries to Protect Brand "Khadi"

Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) has recently secured trademark registrations in three countries – Bhutan, UAE and Mexico – a big stride towards protecting the identity of brand "Khadi" globally. Apart from these countries, KVIC's trademark applications are pending in 40 countries across the world that include the USA, Qatar, Sri Lanka, Japan, Italy, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, Brazil and others.

15.30 LMT free food grains lifted by 31 States/UTs for distribution under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana – IV

The Government of India is running the longest ever exercise of distributing free food grains to the people during COVID-19 pandemic time to ensure food security. Under PMGKAY-IV (July-November 2021), lifting has been started by 31 States and 15.30 LMT food grains have been lifted upto 12th July, 2021.

PM chairs high level meeting to review ramping up of oxygen supply across the Country

- More than 1500 PSA Oxygen plants are coming up across the nation.
- PSA Oxygen plants contributed by PM CARES would support more than 4 lakh oxygenated beds.
- PM instructs officials to ensure that the plants are made functional at the earliest and to deploy advanced technology to track performance and functioning of oxygen plants.

Cabinet approves continuation of centrally sponsored scheme National AYUSH Mission, 14 JUL 2021


• The Union Cabinet chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has approved the continuation of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme from 01-04-2021 to 31-03-2026 with financial implication of Rs. 4607.30 crore. The Mission was launched on 15-09-2014.

The fundamental objective of the National Ayush Mission is to promote the AYUSH systems of medicine through cost-effective services, boosting its educational systems, quality control of AYUSH drugs and ensuring the sustainable availability of AYUSH raw materials.

Jal Jeevan mission -Progress at a glance

To translate Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's vision of providing clean tap water to every household, Union Ministry, Jal Shakti, headed by Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat has been working tirelessly. Jal Jeevan Mission, is envisioned to provide safe and adequate drinking water through individual household tap connections by 2024 to all households in rural India.


- At the start of the Mission in 2019, out of a total of 19.20 Crore rural households in the country, only 3.23 Crore (17%) had tap water supply. During the last 22 months, despite Covid-19 pandemic and lockdown disruptions, Jal Jeevan Mission, has been implemented with speed and 4.42 Crore households have been provided with piped connections.
- With the increase in coverage by 23.36%, presently 7.66 Crore (40.5%) rural households across the country have tap water supply.
- Goa, Telangana, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Puducherry have achieved 100% household connection in rural areas and has become 'Har Ghar Jal'.
