नमस्कार,

भारतीय जनता पार्टी के राष्ट्रीय अध्यक्ष, हम सबके मार्गदर्शक जेपी नड्डा जी, हमारे युवा मोर्चा के युवा साथी, अन्य पदाधिकारीगण और इस कार्यक्रम से जुड़े, देश भर के हमारे नौजवान साथी, शायद मेरे जीवन में इतना बड़ा युवाओं के साथ संवाद करने का ये पहला अवसर है। और शायद दुनिया के किसी राजनेता के लिए भी ये पहला अवसर होगा। और मुझे अच्छा लगा कि नव मतदाता को नमन करने का कार्यक्रम है। नवो नव मतदाता, तो मैं सबसे पहले सभी मतदाताओं को भारत का भाग्य निर्माण करने के लिए नमन करता हूँ निमंत्रित करता हूँ। मैं देख पा रहा हूँ कि बड़ी संख्या में बेटियाँ इस कार्यक्रम से जुड़ी हुई हैं। आज राष्ट्रीय मतदाता दिवस है। इस महत्वपूर्ण दिन देश के सबसे युवा मतदाताओं के बीच आना, अपने आप में ऊर्जा से भर देने वाला है। मैं आप सभी को राष्ट्रीय मतदाता दिवस की बहुत-बहुत बधाई देता हूँ।

साथियों,

18 से 25 वर्ष की आयु ऐसी होती है, जब किसी का भी जीवन, बहुत से बदलावों का साक्षी बनता है। इन्हीं बदलावों के बीच, आप सभी को एक और जिम्मेदारी साथ-साथ निभानी है। ये जिम्मेदारी दुनिया की सबसे बड़ी Democracy में भागीदारी की है। मैं जानता हूँ, कि आपकी Age में किसी भी नई शुरुआत के लिए सबसे ज्यादा एक्साइटमेंट होता है। लेकिन आपकी ये शुरुआत बहुत अलग है। वोटर लिस्ट में नाम रजिस्टर होते ही, अब आप देश के Democratic Process का सबसे महत्वपूर्ण हिस्सा बन गए हैं।

मेरे युवा साथियों,

आप सभी के लिए ये Time Period, ये कालचक्र दो वजहों से बहुत अहम है। एक, आप सभी ऐसे समय में वोटर बने हैं, जब भारत का

साथियों,

जब देश में पूर्ण बहुमत वाली सरकार होती है, जब देश में स्थिर सरकार होती है, तो देश बड़े फैसले लेता है, दशकों से लटकी हुई समस्याओं को सुलझाकर आगे बढ़ता है। आप देखिए, ये हमारी पूर्ण बहुमत की सरकार है जिसमें जम्मू-कश्मीर से आर्टिकल 370 हटाकर दशकों का इंतजार खत्म किया। ये हमारी पूर्ण बहुमत की सरकार है जिसने हमारे देश के जवानों के लिए वन रैंक वन पेंशन लागू कर, देश के पूर्व फौजियों का चार दशक का इंतजार समाप्त किया। ये पूर्ण



सरकार है जिसने नारीशक्ति वंदन अधिनियम बनाकर देश की महिलाओं का बरसों पुराना इंतजार खत्म किया। ये हमारी सरकार है जिसने तीन तलाक के खिलाफ कानून बनाकर मुस्लिम बहन-बेटियों में इंसाफ की उम्मीद बढ़ाई। ये हमारी सरकार है जिसने तीन दशकों के इंतजार के बाद नई राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति लागू की। ये हमारी सरकार है जिसने SC-ST-OBC का हित सुरक्षित रखते हुए भी गरीब युवाओं को भी 10 परसेंट आरक्षण का प्रावधान किया। और, ये हमारी ही सरकार है जिसको अयोध्या में रामलला के विग्रह की प्राण-प्रतिष्ठा का अवसर मिला है। जब देश में पूर्ण बहुमत की सरकार होती है, तो नीति में, निर्णयों में स्पष्टता होती है। इसका सीधा प्रभाव वैश्विक स्तर पर देश की साख पर भी पड़ता है। और साथियों में बताता हूँ, मैं जब दुनिया के बड़े-बड़े दिग्गजों को मिलता हूँ ना, बड़े-बड़े नेताओं को मिलता हूँ ना, दुनिया के कोई भी बड़े देश हो, जब मैं उनसे हाथ मिलाता हूँ ना, तो अकेला मोदी हाथ नहीं मिलाता है, 140 करोड़ देशवासी मेरे साथ खड़े होते हैं, और ये दुनिया को प्रभावित करता है। ये ताकत होती है पूर्ण बहुमत वाली सरकार की। आज दुनिया में भारत की साख एक नई ऊंचाई पर है। आज भारत के पासपोर्ट को बड़े गर्व के साथ देखा जाता है। ये युवाओं के लिए बहुत बड़ी अपॉर्चुनिटी है। इस वजह से बीते वर्षों में भारत में रिकॉर्ड FDI आया है, भारत का विदेशी मुद्रा भंडार भी आज रिकॉर्ड स्तर पर है। कभी सोना गिरवी रखना पड़ता था, लेकिन आज दूसरी स्थिति है। ये देश में रोजगार के भी नए मौके लगातार बना रहा है।

साथियों,

आपको याद होगा, लाल किले से मैंने कहा था कि यही समय है, सही समय है। 10-12 साल पहले भारत में जिस तरह की परिस्थितियाँ थीं, उन्होंने देश के युवाओं का भविष्य अंधकारमय बना दिया था। उस समय आप में से बहुत सारे लोग, कोई आठ साल का होगा, कोई दस साल का होगा, कोई 12 साल का होगा। हो सकता है उस समय की सारी स्थितियाँ आपको पता भी ना हो। आज स्थितियाँ बदली है। हम आज जिन Possibilities की बात कर रहे हैं, 2014 से पहले की जनरेशन ने उनकी उम्मीद तक छोड़ दी थी। आप में से कई न्यूज पेपर्स पढ़ते होंगे। आज हर दिन नई खबर आती है कि देश ने इस सेक्टर में ये बड़ी उपलब्धि हासिल की। लेकिन 2014 से पहले के अखबार खोलिए...आजकल वो सब इंटरनेट पर एवलेबल है। तब आए दिन करप्शन और स्कैम की खबरें छपती थीं, हजारों करोड़ रुपये के घोटाले सामान्य बात थी। उस समय दिन देश के नौजवान सड़कों पर उस समय की सरकार के खिलाफ प्रदर्शन करते थे। मुझे संतोष है कि हम उस अंधकारमय स्थिति से देश को बाहर निकाल पाए हैं। आज Corruption की नहीं, Credibility की बात होती है। आज Scam की नहीं Success Stories की बात होती है। तब भारत फ्रेजाइल फाइव में था, दुनिया सोचती थी कि भारत खुद भी डूबेगा और हमें भी ले डूबेगा। आज भारत पांचवी बड़ी अर्थव्यवस्था है और दुनिया सोचती है कि भारत के विकास से उसका भी विकास होगा। आने वाले कुछ ही वर्षों में भारत दुनिया की टॉप तीन इकॉनॉमी में शामिल हो जाएगा। आने वाले कुछ ही वर्षों में भारत की इकॉनॉमी 7 ट्रिलियन डॉलर को पार कर जाएगी। अर्थव्यवस्था के इतने बड़े विस्तार का बहुत बड़ा लाभ भारत के युवाओं को ही होगा। उनके लिए नए-नए

सेक्टर में रोजगार के बहुत सारे नए मौके बनेंगे। इसलिए ही मैं कहता हूँ, यही समय है, सही समय है।

साथियों,

आज का भारत, सबसे युवा है। इसी युवा प्रेरणा से आज का भारत बड़े लक्ष्य तय करता है और उन्हें प्राप्त भी करता है। सोलर एनर्जी से जुड़े कितने ही लक्ष्य, Renewable Energy से जुड़े लक्ष्य भारत ने तय समय से पहले हासिल करके दिखाए हैं। भारत आज दुनिया को दिखा रहा है कि प्रकृति की रक्षा करते हुए भी विकास कैसे किया जा सकता है। आपने देखा है, भारत की रेलवे ने साल 2030 तक जीरो कार्बन एमिशन का लक्ष्य रखा है, भारत ने साल 2070 तक नेट जीरो का भी लक्ष्य रखा है। आज भारत में इलेक्ट्रिक मोबिलिटी पर अभूतपूर्व जोर दिया जा रहा है। बहुत ही जल्द भारतीय रेलवे का 100 परसेंट इलेक्ट्रिफिकेशन भी होने जा रहा है। इसी 22 जनवरी को सरकार ने सोलर से जुड़ी बड़ी योजना का ऐलान किया है, इस योजना के तहत देश के एक करोड़ घरों में सोलर रूफ टॉप लगाने का लक्ष्य रखा गया है। सरकार का प्रयास है कि हमारे गरीब साथियों का, हमारे मध्यम वर्ग के परिवारों का बिजली बिल तो कम हो ही, कुछ लोगों का तो जीरो भी हो जाएगा। वो सिर्फ बिल नहीं, अपने घर की छत पर जो बिजली पैदा करेंगे, वो बिजली सरकार खरीदेगी और ये परिवार बिजली बेचकर भी पैसे कमा सकें।

साथियों,

आज का भारत आप युवाओं को बड़ी आशाओं से देख रहा है। आप 21वीं सदी के युवा हैं। आपके पास हजारों साल की विरासत है और इंटरनेट एज में फ्यूचर अप्रोच को देखने का सामर्थ्य भी है। दुनिया में ऐसी कोई युवा पीढ़ी नहीं है जिसके पास रामायण और गीता की प्रेरणा और Artificial Intelligence पर काम करने का स्कोप, दोनों हो। आपके पास Tradition की भी ताकत है और Talent की भी ताकत है। आपके पास Inspiration भी है और Innovation भी है। आपके पास संभावनाओं का आसमान है। और साथियों, आपका सामर्थ्य और बढ़े, आपके हर सपने पूरे हों, इसके लिए हमारी सरकार दिन-रात काम कर रही है। और नवजवानों मोदी की गारंटी भी सुन लीजिए, आपके सपने ही मेरे संकल्प हैं। मेरी प्राथमिकता आप सभी युवा ही हैं। मैंने हमेशा देश के युवाओं पर सबसे अधिक विश्वास किया है। इस विश्वास के कारण सरकार ने ऐसे फैसले किए हैं, जो पहले की सरकारों में असंभव से लगते थे। हमारी सरकार ने आप सभी युवाओं के लिए ड्रोन से लेकर स्पेस सेक्टर तक को खोल दिया है। हमने स्टार्टअप नीति बनाकर आपके लिए बिजनेस के नए रास्ते बनाए हैं। हमने मुद्रा योजना के तहत आपको बिना गारंटी बैंक से लोन लेने की सुविधा दी है। आप लोन लीजिए गारंटी मोदी देगा। यूनिवर्सिटी में दाखिले के लिए कॉमन एडमिशन टेस्ट से लेकर फॉर्म अटैस्ट कराने से मुक्ति तक आपके लिए हर चीज आसान करने का काम हमारी सरकार ने किया है। स्पोर्ट्स सेक्टर में आपका टैलेंट आगे लाने के लिए खेलो इंडिया हो या इंटरनेट रिवॉल्यूशन के लिए डिजिटल इंडिया...सभी आपके लिए है। आज देश में एक से बढ़कर एक Higher Education के संस्थान खोले जा रहे हैं...आज देश में रिसर्च और इनोवशन के लिए युवाओं को सरकार हजारों करोड़ रुपये

साथियों,

In its organisation, the then Congress-ruled State Government had to spare a few crores to revamp location roads, replace dysfunctional streetlights and beautify the corridor between the airport and the hotel hosting the meetings. See and assess how the policy of PM Modi made even a lackadaisical Congress Government take charge and provided fellow inhabitants of Raipur, with a scoop of needed development.

When it is about Micro-work, it concerns changing realities amongst population groups, big and small. When development-oriented governance permeates every region, state, district, tehsil, block, and village, with objective and subjective policies, a thriving nation is realised. When a Vande-Bharat is run between Bhubaneswar and Vishakhapatnam, covering 450 kilometres in five and a half hours, the life of a concerned commuter smoothens, also enhancing economic progress between the two coastal states. Visibly, more than what was 'achieved' in previous years has been accomplished within a quarter in 2024. Home Minister Shri Amit Shah recently said that within 2 years of MODI 3.0 - Naxalism will be 'erased' from prevalence. The youth of Chhattisgarh are eager for a time when 'parts' of their state come out of Naxalite-infused paralysis and the reality that they have seen and experienced since childhood.

Unlike others, Prime Minister Modi is truly committed to the cause of 'Yuva'. Whilst his work reflects his experience and wisdom, his energy stories his 'youth-full' passion, curiosity, resilience, and adaptability. 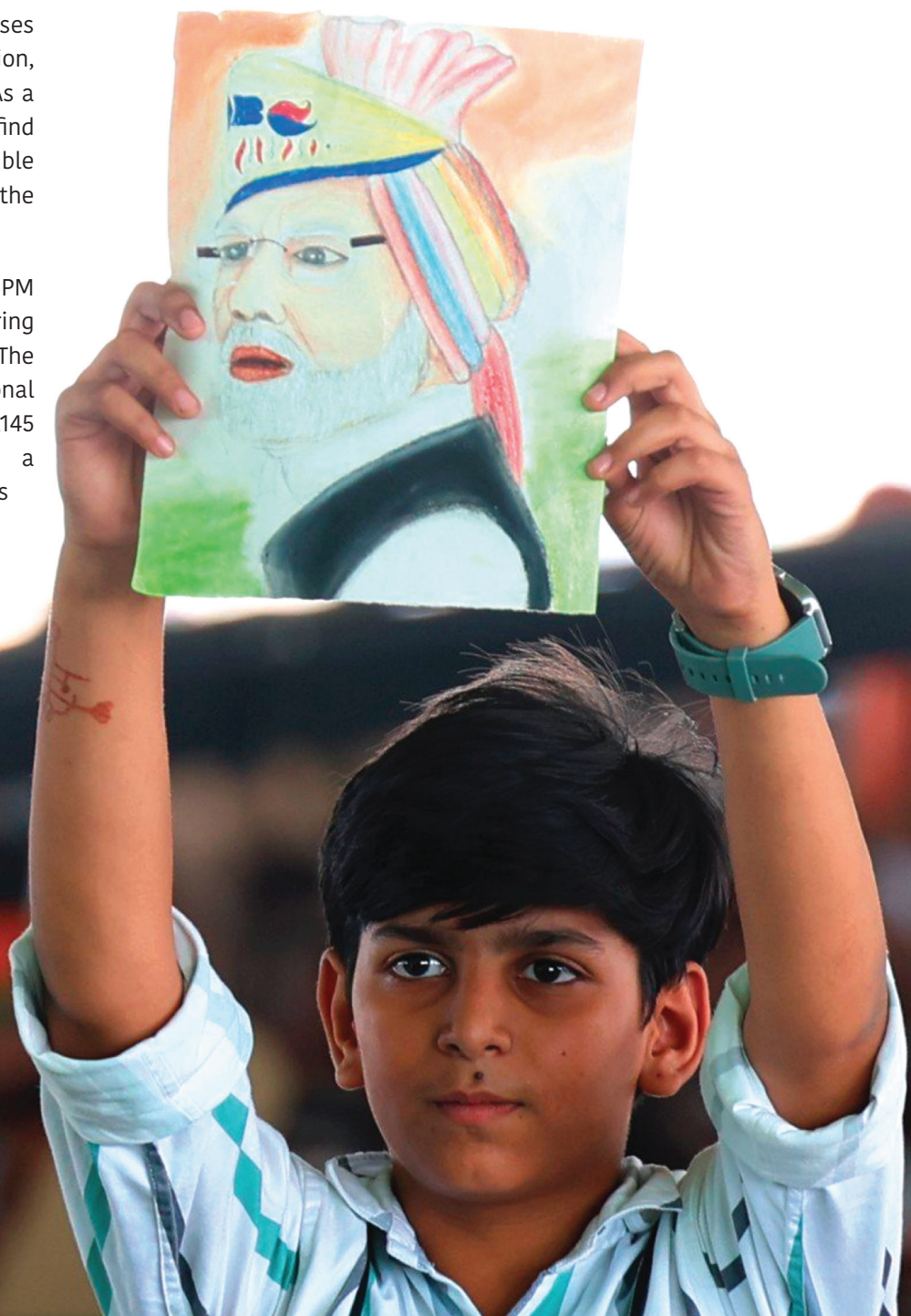

viii) Connecting India Like Never Before

PM Modi's government has been giving a huge boost to infrastructure. Railways, roads, and shipping have been the focus of increasing this infrastructure and aiding in connectivity. The Railway budget focuses on structural and infrastructural reforms. The number of airports has doubled. New trains are announced on a regular rather than annual basis. 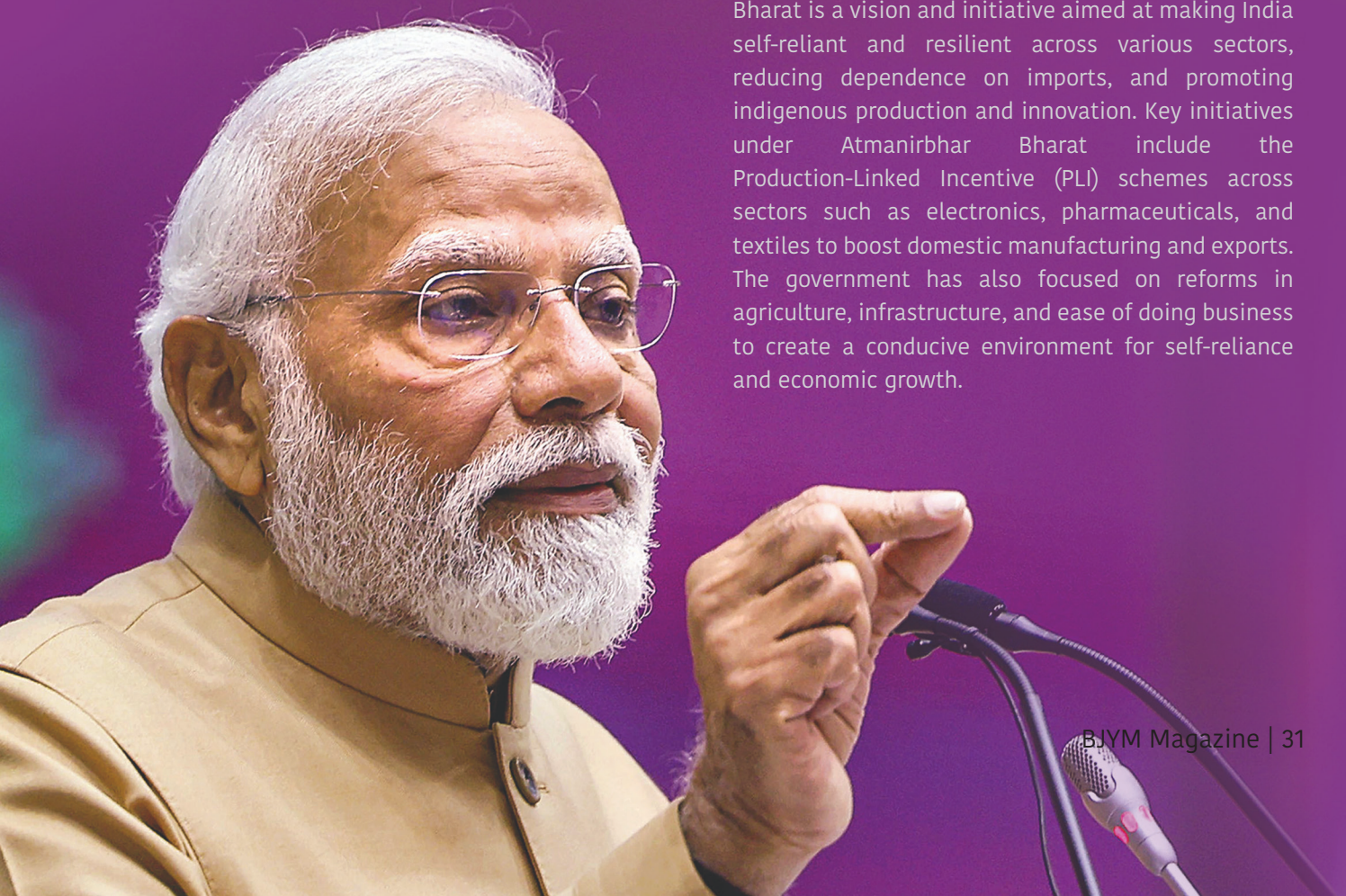

Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (Celebration of 75 Years of Independence) Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav was a series of events and initiatives launched by the government to commemorate 75 years of India's independence and celebrate the country's achievements and progress. The Mahotsav included cultural programs, exhibitions, seminars, and initiatives highlighting India's cultural heritage, freedom struggle, and achievements since independence. It served as a platform to inspire patriotism, promote unity, and reflect on India's journey towards development and self-reliance.

National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 - The National Education Policy 2020 is a comprehensive reform initiative aimed at transforming the education sector in India to meet the needs of the 21st century. Key features of NEP 2020 include a new school curriculum framework, emphasis on holistic and multidisciplinary education, promoting research and innovation, integration of technology in education, and focus on vocational training and skill development. NEP 2020 also emphasizes flexibility in learning pathways, promoting the mother tongue as a medium of instruction, and improving access to quality education for all segments of society.

Hosting G20 Summit - India hosted the most successful G20 summit ever. India has actively contributed to discussions and initiatives within the G20 framework, including on issues such as the digital economy, energy security, financial reforms, and global health challenges such as the COVID-19 pandemic. The G20 platform provided India with an opportunity to present its perspectives on global issues, forge partnerships, and contribute to shaping international policies and agreements.

Additionally, significant steps in the digital economy include the Aadhaar, which is a digital identity in today's time. The impact of all these reforms is that India has the lowest data charges in the world, which has powered Indian youth to have the third-largest startup ecosystem globally.

The STEM subjects have also seen substantial reforms, such as the opening of 7 IITs, 16 IIITs, 15 AIIMS, and 390 universities. The New Education Policy 2020, first after 1985, allows foreign universities to open colleges in India and is also aimed at making India competent at the global level today. The results of these steps in STEM subjects show that India today has the best talent pool of engineers and scientists in the world, which attracts the best companies in the world.

In the field of climate change, India has a first-mover advantage as it aims to have net carbon zero by 2030. India has also spearheaded various global initiatives like the International Solar Alliance, Global Biofuel Alliance, and IBCA, which will add to the capabilities of Indian youth in the coming times. The domestic policies also resonate with the agenda of climate change with the successful oversubscription of India's first tranche of sovereign green bonds launched in 2023.

Empowering the Modi Generation: Unleashing Youth Potential in New India

These kinds of key economic reforms and business-friendly policy initiatives have created a conducive environment for job creation in various sectors of the country. With the introduction of the PLI Scheme in 2020, the Mobile manufacturing industry created 5 lakh new jobs in the country and is expected to add another 2,50,000 jobs by the next 12 months. Companies like Apple and other global brands have queued up to shift their existing units and also establish new assembly lines in India. This growth is not just restricted to Mobile manufacturing. The automobile sector is also projected to create 7.5 lakh job opportunities(Direct and Indirect) in the coming 5 years.

Even in sectors like real estate, thanks to the policies of the Modi government, the size of the real estate market in India is expected to hit \$ 1 trillion in 2030, from \$20 billion in 2017. And job growth in the market has increased from 31 million to 71 million in the year 2023.

Central Government Schemes- Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi wants the youth not just to be job seekers but to emerge as job providers. To create new-age entrepreneurs, the Modi government rolled out the StartUp India scheme in 2016 to build and nurture a strong startup ecosystem through innovation for sustainable economic growth and generate large-scale employment opportunities. Under this scheme, a Fund of Funds for Startups with a corpus of Rs 10,000 crore was created to support the startups. In addition to the earlier fund, a new scheme under the name "Startup India Seed Fund" was launched in 2021 with a corpus of Rs 945 Crores to support 3600 Startups in the country through eligible incubation centres. Thanks to such path-breaking initiatives, the number of startups in India increased from 504 in 2016 to 1,12,718 in December 2023. Till 2016-2017, only one Unicorn company was emerging per year in India, but today, India is home to 111 Unicorns with a total valuation of Rs 34,967 crores, and five startups have emerged as Decacorn Startups. The BJP manifesto for the 2024 elections also promises to improve the schemes for Startups further and encourage setting up Startups in Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities of the country.

To encourage setting up Small and Micro enterprises, Pradhan Mantri MUDRA Yojana(PMMY) was launched in 2016 to provide easy collateral-free credit of Rs 10 lakhs for income-generating activities. A total of 40.82 crore loans were sanctioned, amounting to a total of Rs 23.2 Lakh crores under this scheme till April 2023. Of these, 21% of the loans were sanctioned to new entrepreneurs, and 61% of the total loans were sanctioned to women entrepreneurs.
